Past Years & the Board's Request for FY 2023

- FY 2021: State appropriations were reduced by \$8 million.
- FY 2022: State appropriations remained flat.
- FY 2023: The Board of Regents requested \$15 million increase in state appropriations.

Professional and Scientific Council

House File 2575

- Original bill had flat funding plus \$12 million for a scholarship program for students in high-demand majors.
- Final bill removed scholarship program and increased appropriations.
 - Total increase of \$6.2 million.
 - Of that total, \$5.5 million was earmarked to be divided by the Board between the ISU, UNI, and Iowa.




