









Athletics Department Expenditures (2023)




Expenditures (2005 vs 2023)




Athletics Department Revenues (2023)




Revenue Sources (2005 vs 2023)



Fundraising, Tickets & Other Revenues (2023)




Big 12 Conference Distributions (2022)


