IOWA STATE UNIVERSITY of science and technology

An overdue refresh

•Board of Regents charged the 3 universities to review and update peer institutions for approval at February meeting

Board use for performance benchmarking (retention, graduation rate, ...)
Current "Peer 10" list created in 1986, updated only once (Penn State for Arizona)

•Only 1 names ISU as a peer

•Most have greater admissions selectivity

Most have medical schools

•Most are larger

•In parallel, a second "IPEDS peer list" with 97 (!) institutions, no historical documentation of selection decisions

The review process

•Started from 24 candidate institutions

•Land grant, R1

Used IPEDS, NSF HERD, and other reputable data sources for accurate and consistent comparisons of a wide range of indicators
Examined different weighting factors and correlations among indicators

•Goals

Identify schools similar to Iowa State across a broad range of indicators where we rank near middle on most
Good fit exists on institutional mission and culture

Features of the new list

- •We ranked in the middle (5th-7th) in most categories Exceptions: We are towards the top in STEM enrollment, and towards the bottom for cost of attendance/tuition and operating revenues per FTE.
- •8 list ISU as peer (all but Purdue, NC State)
- •3 have human medical schools
- •9 have a veterinary medicine college
- •Enrollments range from 22,000-50,000
- •All are land grant with Extension
- Coast-to-coast

IPEDS list

•Previously, 97 institutions and last updated in 2006

•Replacing with 29 institutions

- •The 10 new Board of Regents peers
- •The 8 institutions that previously were peers (the 7 swapped from Board's peer list, plus the University of Arizona)
- •11 additional R1s that offer a broad national perspective (ASU, SUNY Buffalo, Clemson, Georgia, Kentucky, LSU, Maryland, Tennessee, Texas Tech, WSU, WVU)


